We have been performing as a duo in the unusual but exciting violin/viola formation for four years now. As a Finnish-German group – we met in Helsinki in 2012 – we particularly cherish the music of our home countries, and have played in both Finland and Germany.

As performers, we find it most important to share our great passion for music with the audience. The presentation of our concerts has developed into a practical method for building a bridge between us and the listeners. Our artistic ideals have substantially grown through our experience as members of the Baltic Sea Philharmonic under the baton of Kristjan Järvi, and the Norwegian chamber ensemble 1B1 Group. As an ensemble that succeeds in peacefully bringing together musicians from 10 different countries, the Baltic Sea Philharmonic additionally stands as an example for the important role that music plays in society.
